

Updated Onsite Safety Procedures



We understand the uncertainty and anxiety surrounding the COVID-19 pandemic. Please know that the safety of our students is our primary concern. To that end, we have implemented the following regulations for all of our on-site courses:

- We have reduced class size to 8 students in order to not exceed the 10-person limit on gatherings, and will continue to do so until the limit is increased
- Students will have their own table and chair to ensure more than the required 6' of physical distancing
- Students must bring a face mask to class and wear it when working with the horses
- Hand sanitizer will be utilized between each student's application of techniques on the horse
- Your instructor and teaching assistant will diligently disinfect their hands often during the course
- Students must wash their hands prior to arriving in class, after breaks, before leaving the classroom, after sneezing, coughing or touching their face and before and after working on the horses
- We will have hand sanitizer onsite, but ask that students bring a personal container that can be easily accessed at all times
- We will have latex-free gloves onsite if deemed necessary
- Please disinfect items brought into the classroom before class and when you return home
- We will not have a hostess table with snacks and refreshments - please bring your own (please also bring a refillable water bottle)
- Students must practice safe physical distancing at all times
- Additional safety regulations may be implemented in accordance with current CDC guidelines

MOST IMPORTANTLY

- If you have been exposed to COVID-19 within 14 days of the course or you feel ill prior to the course, **DO NOT COME TO CLASS**. We will reschedule you in a future course.

In the event we must cancel a course due to COVID-19, we will refund your deposit and any monies paid toward the course tuition. We look forward to seeing you in class!
